**DATES:** April 14<sup>th</sup>, May 19<sup>th</sup>, June 9<sup>th</sup>, July 14<sup>th</sup>, August 11<sup>th</sup>, September 8<sup>th</sup>, October 13<sup>th</sup>, and November 10<sup>th</sup> 2024

**PLACE:** Mount Joy Sportsmen's Association located at 85 Range Road, Mount Joy, PA 17552

**DIRECTIONS:**

**From York:** Take Rt. 30 East to Columbia Rt. 441 North. Then turn right on Rt. 772 to Mount Joy.

**From Reading, PA area:** Take Rt. 222 South to Rt. 30 West and then Rt. 283 West. Take exit for Manheim/Mount Joy Rt. 772 and turn left to Mount Joy.

**From Philadelphia area:** Take PA Turnpike (I-76 W) to Rt. 222 South to Rt. 30 West. Then go to Rt. 283 West and take exit for Rt. 772 Manheim/Mount Joy. Turn left to go to Mount Joy.

**Then:** Go down Rt. 772 to Mount Joy. Turn right on Old Market St. (turn left onto Old Market Street if coming from York/Columbia) past Cove Outlook Park and Lancaster CTC to club parking lot.

**TIME:** Registration from 8:30 am to 8:55 am on the day of the match; relay assignments are on a first-come/first-serve basis (no advance sign-up) and limited to the first 24 shooters or four relays; first relay starts at 9:00; squadding for pit and scoring services will be done at registration

**MATCH FEE:** Adult competitors \$10.00 / no cost for Juniors

**COMPETITION:** Open to all shooters; beginners are welcome - instruction is available.

**CLASSIFICATION:** CMP classification will be used; for award presentations, a class have no less than 5 shooters.

**RULES:** Current CMP High Power Rifle rules will apply. Challenges \$1.00 Matches will be conducted as CMP Cup Match event with sighters and starting rapid-fire series in position. Competitors will be required to pull targets OR OTHER DUTIES AS ASSIGNED

**COURSE OF FIRE:** 50 shot National Match Course (reduced) - 2 sighter shots in 2 minutes prior to each stage:  
Stage #1: 10 rounds Slow Fire Standing; 200 yards; 10 minutes  
Stage #2: 1 string - 10 rounds Rapid Fire Sitting; 200 yards; 60 sec/string  
Stage #3: 1 strings - 10 rounds Rapid Fire Prone; 200 yards; 70 sec/string  
Stage #4: 20 rounds Slow Fire Prone; 200 yards; 20 minutes

**GENERAL INFO:**

1. All shooters should possess an internet capable device (smart phone, tablet, laptop, etc.) for scoring purposes. A limited number of club devices will be available to borrow.
2. All scoring will be done via Shotmarker electronic target system. CMP E-Target rules and scoring will be used.
3. During rapid fire even and odd firing points will alternate firing to reduce risk of lost shots on target system.
4. Club M1 Garand, M1 Carbine, and AR15 rifles will be available for use by all shooters; ammo will be provided @ \$30.00. All ammo distributed MUST be fired at the match.
5. POSITIVELY NO HANDLOADS WILL BE USED IN ANY CLUB RIFLES; only factory loaded, non-corrosive ammo will be allowed in club rifles (chief range officer reserves the right to inspect and approve/disapprove all ammo used for the match).
6. Courses of fire may be altered at Match director's discretion.
